The Difference between Faith and Belief

Faith: The conviction of the truth of anything, belief; in the NT of a conviction or belief respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, generally with the included idea of trust and holy fervor born of faith and joined with it

Relating to God: the conviction that God exists and is the creator and ruler of all things, the provider and bestower of eternal salvation through Christ

Relating to Christ: a strong and welcome conviction or belief that Jesus is the Messiah, through whom we obtain eternal salvation in the kingdom of God

Belief: to support, confirm, be faithful, uphold, nourish

- to be established, be faithful, be carried, make firm
- confirmed, established, sure

- reliable, faithful, trust
- to stand firm, to trust, to be certain, to believe in

Leave - verb - 'āzab (ah-zey-av)

- to leave, loose, forsake
- to depart from, leave behind, leave, let alone
- to abandon, forsake, neglect
- to let loose, set free, let go, free
- to be left to
- to be forsaken
- to be deserted
- to restore, repair

But you will not leave in haste or go in flight; for the LORD will go before you, he God of Israel will be your rear guard. Isaiah 52:12 NASB

To go out - verb - yāṣā' (yat-sa)

- to go out, come out, exit, go forth
- to go or come out or forth, depart
- to go forth (to a place)
- to go forward, proceed to (to or toward something)
- to come or go forth (with purpose or for result)
- to come out of
- to cause to go or come out, bring out, lead out
- to bring out of
- to lead out
- to deliver
- to be brought out or forth

Get out - verb - anachōreō (ah-nah-hor-aye-oh)

- to go back, return
- to withdraw
- so as to leave a room
- of those who through fear seek some other place, or shun sight

Epigenetics

Epigenetics is the study of how your behaviors and environment can cause changes that affect the way your genes work. Unlike genetic changes, epigenetic changes are reversible and do not change your DNA sequence, but they can change how your body reads a DNA sequence.
